

Accommodations for people with disabilities working with the Social Security Administration

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 prohibits discrimination against qualified individuals with disabilities. Individuals with disabilities may request one or more accommodations. Individuals do not have to prove a disability when requesting an accommodation. We accept accommodations requests based on the individual's alleged disability.

To request an accommodation, an individual may:

- call our National 800 Number (1-800-772-1213);
- visit a local field office (FO), including a Social Security Number Card Center, or hearing office (HO);
- call an FO or HO where they would like to receive the accommodation; or
- write to an FO or HO where they would like to receive the accommodation.
